[REDACTED] was sentenced on March 9, 2009, to four months of custody and a three year term of supervised release, relative to his plea of guilty to one count of Possession of Stolen Explosives. Special conditions included regular monthly child support payments in accordance with any payment plan established by state authorities and home detention for a period of four months. [REDACTED] commenced supervised release on August 7, 2009, and completed home detention in December 2009. He has consistently made monthly child support payments. On May 24, 2011, [REDACTED] filed a motion requesting early termination of supervised release. This officer conferred with the Court and reported that [REDACTED] adjustment during supervision has been positive, he appears to be in compliance, and the Probation Office has no objection to early termination. The Court directed this officer to prepare an order and this Report and Order Terminating Supervised Release Prior to Original Expiration Date is submitted with the recommendation that [REDACTED] be discharged from supervised release.
